

## Online event hosted by Da Vinci College Dordrecht 1 – 3 June 2021

The EfVET Thematic Teams have an annual meeting in spring, this year Da Vinci College in Dordrecht was the host. We really hoped to be able to meet in Dordrecht, to discuss the work done by the different TT's. If not possible to meet with a large group, it would have been great to experience to organize a blended version of this event, with people online and either physically attending in Dordrecht.



The meeting is a synergy where different activities of EfVET members come together, next to the Thematic Teams is the Innovet project working on a 'model for future conferences' and InterVET WB, a pilot KA3 project where VET colleges in the EU share their experiences with colleges in six countries in the Western Balkan.

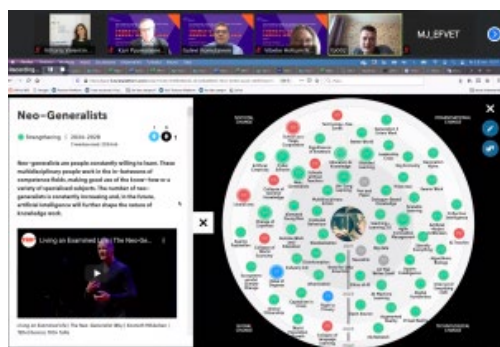

In spite of this the event was of high quality with interesting keynote speakers on how Europe is looking at the Future of the VET sector by Joao Santos and how to work with Avatars to meet online in project activities by Keuda, Finland.



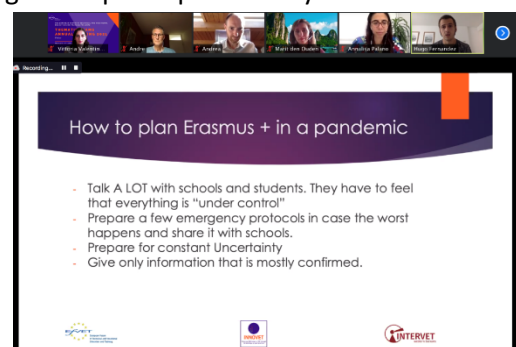
How to 'predict' the future to be able to make a policy plan for VET colleges was introduced by

Tuomo Kuosa, a Finnish Futurist. The TT VET 4.0 is working on different scenarios. The main purpose is to understand the impact of the different changes happening at different levels (namely: societal, organizational, technological, global and Industry) in the VET sector and anticipate coping measures.



The EfVET TT on Internationalisation & Learning Mobilities challenged the participants. They were asked to come up

with solutions and to share their ideas, suggestions in a role-play-workshop about 'how to start up mobility after Covid-19'. We realize that we will have to deal with the virus as it is a reality, so how can we work safe and still give students the possibility to go abroad? Many suggestions came up and the results will be send to all participants and published broadly.
